The Ageing in Place Pathfinder has successfully delivered another project, Observing Moorside, which was delivered by Marguerite Heywood from Castlefield Art Gallery, she taught us how to express our feelings and thoughts through words and pictures, looking at Moorside and what area is special to the residents and why.

The Ageing in Place Pathfinder has set up a great activity session partnered with Wheels4All to deliver a 50+ session. Weekly sessions will start from 31st August at Clarence Park.
